Sunset Country Quilter's Guild Miniature Quilt Auction – 2016

Definition: A miniature quilt is a scaled down version of a larger quilt. In other words, all elements of a miniature quilt (blocks, borders, sashing, etc.) should be reduced in size to a proportion that matches the size of the quilt.

- 1. Total perimeter of the quilt shall be less than 96 inches and no single side shall be more that 24 inches in length.
- 2. Miniature quilts may be pieced, appliqued, embroidered, wholecloth, etc. and may be quilted by machine or hand.
- 3. If you would like, a label should be securely sewn to the back of the quilt with your name and the date you made the quilt. (Years from now people would like to remember who made this quilt.)
- 4. Each entry shall be accompanied by a separate Entry Form. Entry Forms and quilts must be turned into Joan Schneider by **Friday**, **April 22, 2016**.
- 5. Quilts will be displayed at the Sunset Quilter's Guild Quilt Show in April 2016. Members of the public as well as guild members and other quilters will have the opportunity to bid on your masterpiece "silent auction style". Draws for the winners will take place between 1:00 pm and 2:00 pm on Sunday, May 1, 2016 at the Quilt Show.
