

## Sunset Country Quilter's Guild Miniature Quilt /Small Wall Hanging Auction 2018

Definition: A miniature quilt is a scaled down version of a larger quilt. In other words, all elements of a miniature quilt (blocks, borders, slashing, etc.) should be reduced in size to a proportion that matches the size of the quilt. Please Note that we are also accepting small wall hangings for this auction. The criteria for both the miniature quilts and wall hangings are as follows:

1. Total perimeter of the quilt shall be less than 96 inches, and no single side shall be more than 24 inches in length.
2. Miniature quilts may be pieced, appliquéd, embroidered, wholecloth, etc. and may be quilted by machine or by hand.
3. If you would like, a label should be securely sewn to the back of the quilt with your name and the date you made the quilt. (Years from now people would like to remember who made this quilt.)
4. Each entry shall be accompanied by a separate Entry Form and must be turned in to Joan Schneider by **Friday April 27, 2018.**
5. Quilts will be displayed at the Sunset Quilter's Guild Quilt Show in April, 2018. Members of the public as well as guild members and other quilters will have the opportunity to bid on your masterpiece "silent auction style". Draws for the winners will take place after 2:00 p.m. on April 29, 2018 at the Quilt Show.

**6. You may enter as many quilts as you would like!**
