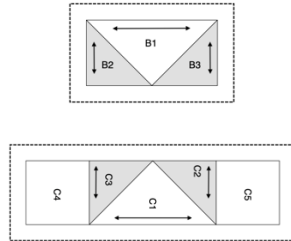
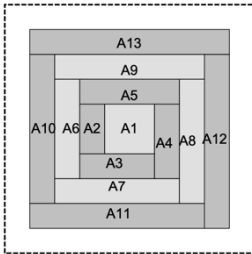

Miniature Block of the Month 2022

Block 5 Log Cabin Star

The Log Cabin Star block is made up of a center log cabin block (A) set in a star made with 4 flying geese units: 2 just geese (B) and 2 with corner squares added (C). We will not be using paper templates when cutting our pieces this time. Yahoo!

If you are using alternating Light background fabrics, the background in this block is Light #2.

Light (Background #2)

1 – 4" square cut diagonally **twice** = 4 right angle triangles

4 – 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " squares

Medium

1 – 1" square

1 –  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 8"; cut a  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " for A6;  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " for A7;  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " for A8;  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 2" for A9

4 – 2  $\frac{1}{4}$ " squares cut diagonally **once** = 8 right angle triangles

Dark

1 –  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 6"; cut a  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 1" for A2;  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " for A3;  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " for A4;  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " for A5

1 –  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 10"; cut a  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " for A10;  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " for A11;  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " for A12;  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " for A13

NOTE: When sewing the A unit, trim each seam sewn to **less than  $\frac{1}{4}$ "** or you will be sewing them into the next seam.

Paper piece 1 A unit, 2 B units and 2 C units. Press well. Trim along the dashed edge of each unit with the quarter inch line of the ruler on the solid line of the pattern to ensure an exact seam allowance is achieved. Remove the foundation paper sections in reverse order of construction.

Sew the B units to opposite sides of your log cabin (A) unit. Press seam towards the center. Sew each C unit to the remaining sides of your B+A+B piece and press the seams open. Square up the block to 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (if necessary) and celebrate your achievement!!
