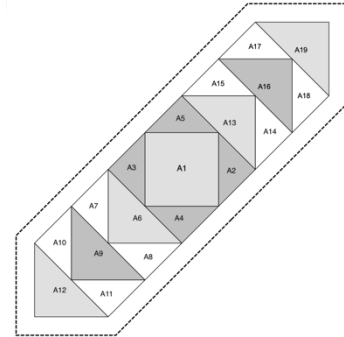
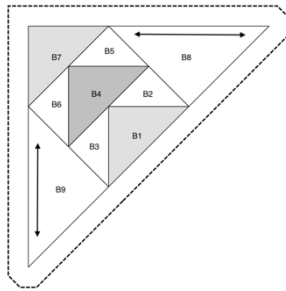
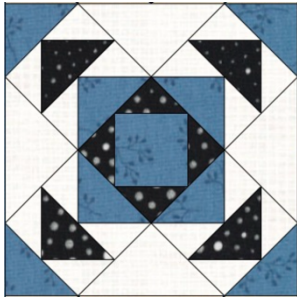

Miniature Block of the Month 2022

Block 7 Wild Geese

General Paper Piecing Preparation documentation can be found on the introduction page of the 2022 Mini BOM tab at sunsetcountryquilters.org.

The Wild Geese block is made with three units, 1 central panel and 2 identical triangle units. All the fabric pieces are cut from squares, so no templates are needed. You will be pleased with how quickly this block comes together!



If you are using alternating Light background fabrics, the background in this block is #1.

Light (**Background #1**)

1 – 4" square cut diagonally twice to make 4 triangles: 2 for each Unit B

8 – 2" squares cut diagonally once to make 16 triangles: 8 for Unit A and 4 for each Unit B

Medium

4 – 2¼" squares cut diagonally once to make 8 triangles: 4 for Unit A and 2 for each Unit B

1 – 1½" x 1½" square for center of Unit A

Dark

2 – 2¼" squares cut diagonally once to make 4 triangles: 2 for Unit A and 1 for each Unit B

2 – 1¾" squares cut diagonally once to make 4 small triangles for Unit A

Construct the foundation units. Press each well with a stabilizing spray. Trim outside edges along the dashed line placing the quarter inch line of your ruler on the straight line of the pattern to create accurate ¼" seam allowances. Remove the foundation paper.

Sew a Unit B to each side of Unit A. Press the seam open.

Give the block a final, crisp press with starch, square up by cutting off any 'dog ears' and celebrate!
