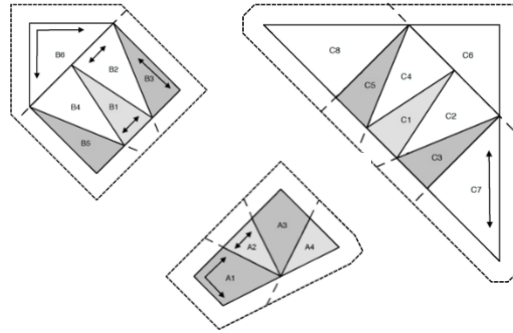
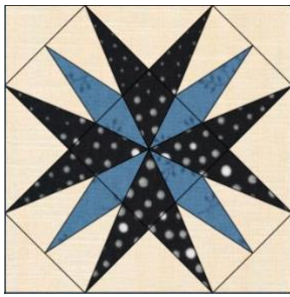

Miniature Block of the Month 2022

Block 12 Pointed Star

Pointed Star is made with 3 pairs of Units. A two colour block on point sets the center for radiating star points. Sharp narrow triangles continue the colour pattern out making it appear that the star points are each a single piece of fabric. It is a simple pattern for a complex looking block.



Light (**Background #2**)

1 – 3½" square cut diagonally twice

2 – 2½" squares cut diagonally once

2 – 2" x 5" right sides together. Use B2 as template and add ⅜" on all sides. Make 8.

Medium

2 – 2" x 2½" right sides together. Use B1 as template and add ⅜" on all sides. Make 4.

2 – 1½" x 2½" right sides together. Use A2 as template and add ⅜" on all sides. Make 4.

Dark

2 – 2" x 3" right sides together. Use A1 as template and add ⅜" on all sides. Make 4.

2 – 2" x 4" right sides together. Use B3 as template and add ⅜" on all sides. Make 8.

Construct the foundation units. Press each well with a stabilizing spray. Trim outside edges along the dashed line placing the quarter inch line of your ruler on the straight line of the pattern to create accurate ¼" seam allowances. Remove the foundation paper.

Sew the 2 Unit A segments together along the center seam. Press the way the seam wants to lie – half to each side. Sew each Unit B to opposite sides of the center block. Press seams toward the center. Add each Unit C and press the seams open.

Give the block a final, crisp press with starch. Carefully square up to 4½" and celebrate!
